From the Principal's Desk



Unprecedented times

To our school community – Firstly I would like to acknowledge and thank all the teachers and staff for their commitment to supporting our school and our community. It has been a challenging few weeks and no more than this week. Our school is open, however learning is moving to an online platform that is consistent and fair for all children especially our children working from home.

Our school executive team worked tirelessly yesterday to ensure that all online learning was ready to go. We have set up an online platform on our school website – please access all online content via the school website. We also have work packs that are replicas of the online content available for pick up from the school. Times to pick up the packs have been posted on Facebook and Skoolbag app.

If you are not receiving skoolbag app updates or Facebook updates – please email the office to update your contact details – especially your email address so we can continue to send electronic communication.

Thank you to our amazing students, they are trying their best to stay apart, however given their ages and innocence it can be a challenge. We are doing our best to observe the social distancing procedures by encouraging children to be apart. We have been increasing the hygiene practices of the students, staff and visitors to our school. We have closed some classrooms and have spaced our classes across interconnecting classrooms to allow equal supervision of students.

All classroom resources are being cleaned by our teachers and support staff and I thank you.

Could I please remind all parents/carers dropping their children to school do so by observing the social distancing requirements. Please do not mingle together – please enter the school to drop off and pick up children only and minimise any group gatherings.

Our canteen is not able to run and is therefore closed. We have capacity to make lunches so no child misses out on food, we are also supported by Christ Mission Charity who make lunches for children – but I would encourage you to ensure your children come to school with lunch and recess if you are sending them to school.

Currently we have around 8 staff who are unable to work from school so they are working from home and are available to communicate through CLASS DOJO. Over the coming weeks we will move all learning to google classroom. More information to come.

I would also like to thank you all for your patience, your thoughtfulness and your support as we navigate through this together.

Please see below the letter that was sent home yesterday to all families – we are encouraging all families to use the CLASS DOJO app to communicate with teachers

Dear Parents and Carers,

On Monday 23rd March, our Premier announced that where possible, parents should keep children home from school.

If you cannot keep your child at home as you work in an essential service, school will be open. Students will be doing the work at school that is being sent home. **Regular classroom teaching will not continue in these circumstances.**

In the coming days, we will be providing work packs for all students in every class to work from home. We will let you know as soon as these are available for you to pick up for your child.

These work packs will include:-

- a suggested timetable (we will update and distribute weekly for as long as required)
- hard copies of work students can do at home if you have no internet access
- access to the following to online learning resources via, Prodigy, Storyline online, Go Noodle,

and access our daily facebook live reading and fitness sessions.

- both parent and student login information for Class DOJO and student DoE Portal access.

All teachers will be available between 8.30am and 3:30 pm to answer any questions you or your child have about the work, via CLASS DOJO – please download the app.



Throughout the coming weeks we will be posting a variety of videos via the Facebook page for children to watch, such as readings, spelling lessons, maths activities, fitness and art activities. These will be prepared by our teachers and include learning activities.

If you do not have access to CLASS DOJO, information will be available from the office. Please ensure that your email address and telephone numbers are current so we can maintain contact via the phone with your child/ren.

Please note:-

From today onwards the canteen will be closed. The school will have no access for children to order lunch/please ensure you send your child/ren to school with lunch and recess.
















S1A have been having fun with science, making spaghetti towers
